
A Bad Good Man -3

It is natural to positively employ a person who seems good.


Mr.Lookbad regarded Mr.Tattoo as a bad man, so Mr.Lookbad treats Mr.Tattoo based on his recognition.

For example, if Mr.Lookbad is an interviewer of the job;




It is natural to refuse a person who seems bad.

Mr.Tattoo was employed by Mr.Seegood's company. Immediately after, Mr.Tattoo stole the money and run away.




As a result, Mr.Seegood's company ended up being bankrupt.
