The next day the woman went to visit her new neighbor. She was interested in how strong he looked like.







If you have never met someone, misunderstanding may arise more easily than the case of meeting someone for the first time.

Now let me change the subject to something bigger.


Imagine there are 2 nations of which culture and language are completely different. The 2 countries are located faraway and the most of the citizens have never met each other before.





And imagine that whatever the reason is, these kinds of information below about the B nationals are spread among A nationals.
