Do you think it is a lie? How about imagining this? Now let's imagine that you prepare a present for your enemy. You buy some sweets and put it in a box tied with a ribbon.






You see, loving your enemy wasn't too hard? What you needed was just a bit of money.

This time, you receive a present from someone whom you think is your enemy.




So here is the present from your enemy. What could it be? What's inside? Could it be a bomb? If so, if you opened it, it would explode!




Or could it be a venomous snake?

Naturally, as if your enemy would give you something you like. If it really is chocolates, they must be poisonous.






See, you get it now. To love someone is very easy.
